



Hey Doorflower!

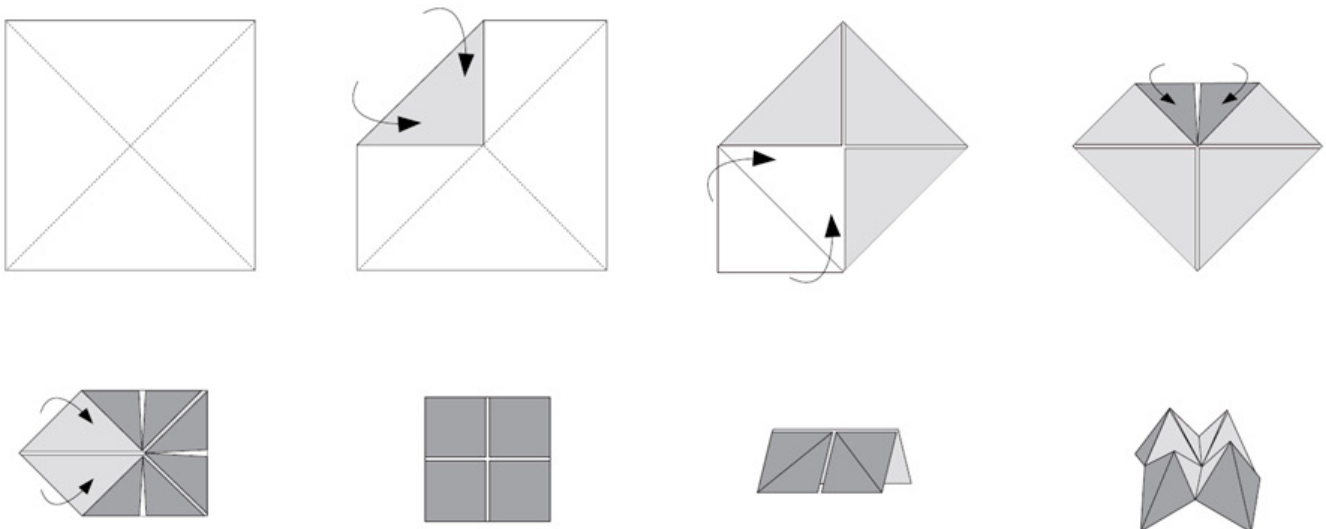

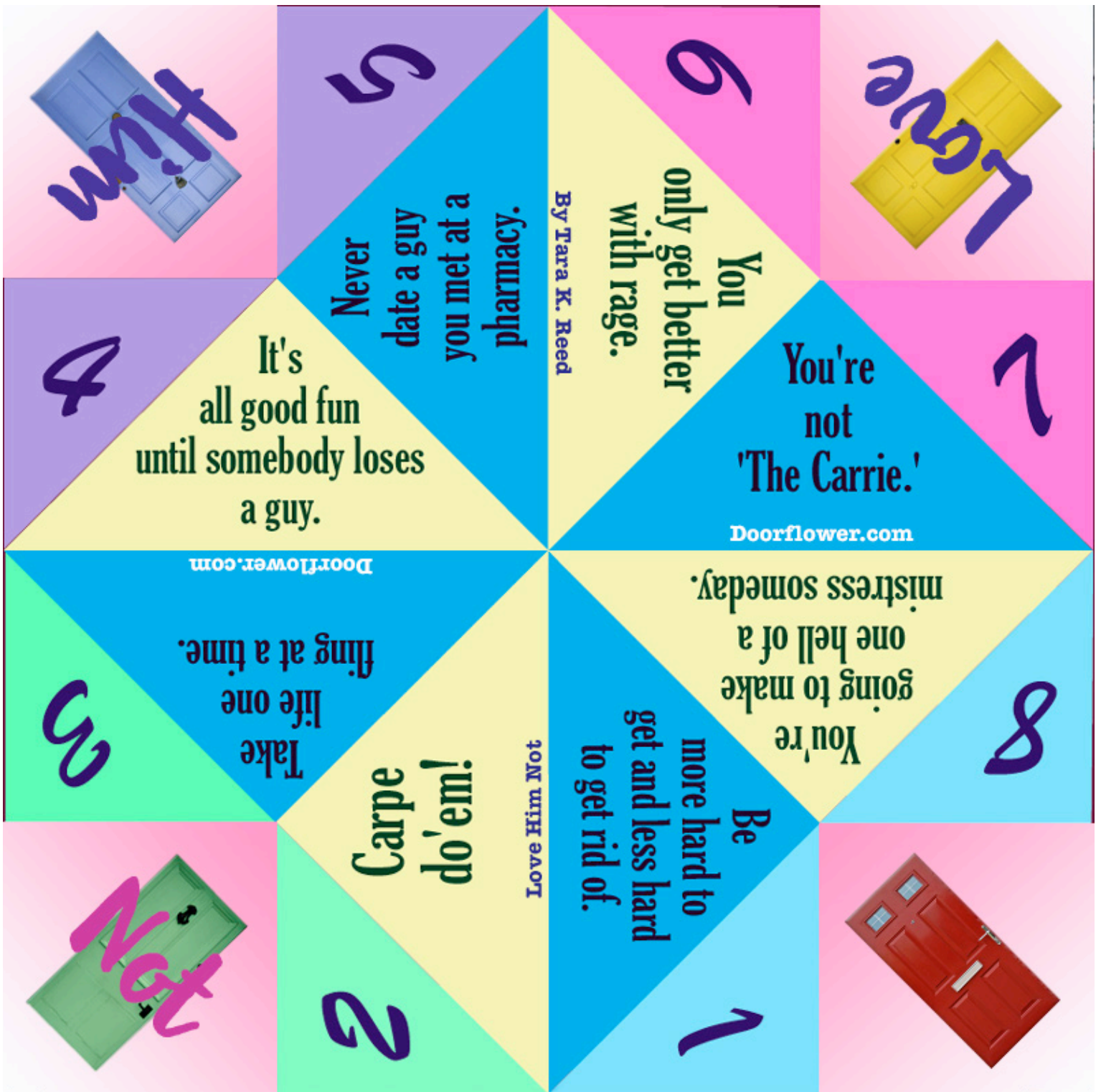
You'll need to cut off the bottom, where you'll find a couple of cards to give your friends when they ask you where you got it. That is, *if* you want them to have one, too.
